### **Nearly Every Gun Owner Makes This Mistake**

When you carry concealed, are you also carrying a spare magazine or speed loader? Too many gun owners answer "no" to this question. Here are 8 reasons you should.

### 1. Multiple Attackers

You could face a gang of attackers.

- You might even find yourself in a terrorist/active shooter scenario.
- If that happens, you need as much ammo as you can carry. It's rare, but it DOES happen.

### 2. "Armored Up" Active Shooters

There is a disturbing trend in "active shooters" wearing body armor. It takes more ammo to put these shooters down.

 Even if you hit the armor, punching it repeatedly could help buy you time.

### 3. Drugs

People who can't feel pain will keep operating until they bleed out. You'll need enough rounds available to put them down.

• You'll need to put multiple shots into someone who's high on, say, PCP.

## 4. Fear Could Cause You To Blow Through Your Ammo

People shoot faster when they're afraid.

 If you empty your gun too fast, you need a reload! The "click" that happens when your gun is empty could cost you your life.

### **5. Most Bullets WON'T Hit Your Target**

Even trained police miss in real shootouts.

- 3 out of 4 of your shots will likely miss.
- Hedge your bets by carrying more ammo.

#### 6. The Dead Man's 10 Seconds

Even an attacker who has been fatally shot will keep fighting back for several seconds before he goes down.

 Having more ammo allows you to keep hitting him until he's actually down.

# 7. Dropping Your Magazine In A Struggle

Your gun's magazine release is a liability.

- You could drop the mag during a struggle.
- You'll need a reload if this happens!

#### 8. Weapon Malfunction/Bad Magazine

A semi-automatic pistol is a mechanical device. It is very dependent on its magazines.

 If you experience a malfunction, physical damage from impact, or your magazine doesn't work properly, only a spare mag puts your gun back into action.

#### **Four Ways To Carry Extra Ammo**

There are several options for carrying ammo:

- Mag or speed loader carrier on your belt
- Ankle carry magazine holster
- Off-body (briefcase, bag, backpack, etc.)
- Pocket carry with <u>SnagMag</u> (preferred)

Prepare. Train. Survive.
