Defending Your Bugout Vehicle

Your neighbors and other "refugees" in an emergency can turn desperate. When they do, they'll get aggressive and even violent. You need to be able to protect your Bugout Vehicle, your family, and your resources when you are bugging out. The safest place to be is at home, but you may be forced to leave. You need firearms, but you likely won't store them in your vehicle. These 5 weapons are safe, [mostly] legal, can be stored in the vehicle, and effective for protecting yourself from...

- Roaming hordes of refugees
- Gangs and Looters
- Civilian Militias/Checkpoints

1. Portable Spotlight

Useful for if you are being chased.

- A handheld rechargeable spotlight.
- The best ones are LED.
- Typically they have pistol grips.
- These are super-bright.
- A million candlepower light is ideal.
- Shining this into the pursuing driver's eyes at night will distract them.

2. Large Metal Bolts

Another item useful when you are being chased.

- 3-4 inches long; threaded bolts.
- Any small, heavy metal item can work.
- Keep a "tactical pouch" of several steel bolts. These have sharp edges and are great for shattering windows.
- You can toss them out of your sunroof if you have one to deter pursuers.

3. Paintball Gun

This is a third item that is useful if you are chased or you see a mob up ahead.

- It's best to have a gunner who can operate this while you drive.
- Peppering the pursuing vehicle's windshield with paintballs will make it hard for them to see. They'll try to clean the windshield, but the paint will smear and make a mess.
- Couple the use of your paintball gun with some defensive driving maneuvers.
- Fire regular or tear gas/pepper ball rounds to scatter a crowd as you approach. There are even hard paintball rounds that will crack skulls.

4. Taser/Baton/Flashlight

Check your local laws. This item is useful if you are stopped by a mob or at a checkpoint.

- Don't just step on the gas and try to ram through. You'll get caught on the bodies.
- Keep moving SLOWLY forward. The mob, however, will try to smash your vehicles.
- Useful for fighting off people who reach into your vehicle. Get one with an "attack bezel."

5. Fire Extinguisher

A useful safety tool that can deter crowds or provide temporary cover.

- Get a small one with a hose so you can poke it out the cracked window and spray.
- The pray is unpleasant and hard to see through.
